 - We need to engage families with kids.
 - Cindy: we should promote to schools in early May.
 - Event congestion can create accessibility issues.
 - 1200-1500 at Hmong Day. Busiest in the morning.
 - Marie: is there a band that performs for kids?
 - Performers need to represent various demographics.
 - SEVEN performer slots, NOT twelve. One stage, not two.
 - Stage is outside, weather permitting.
 - Hilary: Can we have a quiet space people can go to? Yes.
 - Andy: is a stage necessary? If so, we need a ramp. Most agree we need a stage. Andy will look into renting a stage.
